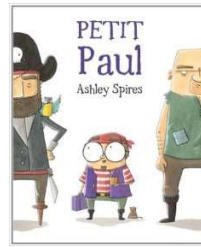

DRESSING FOR WINTER

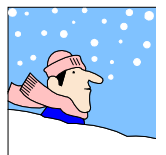
Please remember to dress your children in proper cold weather clothes. Make sure that they have a hat, warm gloves, scarf, boots and winter coats. Please remember that student must have 2 pairs of shoes at school.

As I am sure you can understand, when students wear outdoor foot-ware inside the school and inside the classrooms, it makes the halls and classroom floors extremely dirty. Your help in following this policy is greatly appreciated.

CONTINGENCY PLANS

The Lester B. Pearson School Board will attempt to broadcast all cancellations on Radio Station CJAD (800). In the event that school must close during the day due to an emergency situation (i.e. power failure, burst water pipe, etc.), your child must know where to go if no one is at home. Please discuss with your child what to do if he or she should come home and you are not there. It may happen occasionally that you may be stuck in traffic or at a metro station, or the school may have to close unexpectedly. All children from K to 6 should know what to do in such circumstances.
