### Coordinator's Corner

Our Grade 6 students have participated in a Symposium on Energy on November 23<sup>rd</sup>. This Symposium was to help them decide which Topic related to Energy (how it's shared around the world and how we will share it in the future) for their Exhibition which will held in February, 2018.



In the [Primary Years Programme \(PYP\)](#), students are encouraged to be curious and caring lifelong learners with the capacity to take responsible action. A crucial part of the programme is the PYP exhibition, a culminating in-depth and collaborative project held during the final year of the programme. Researchers at the University of Nottingham in the UK have gathered data about the impact of the Exhibition process on students, parents and teachers.

**Parents** were impressed by their child's achievements, skills, and maturity. They valued the exhibition for helping to develop 21st-century skills, such as internet searching, evaluating information and reflectiveness.

**Students** in the study talked about learning to critically evaluate sources of information for their projects. **Teachers** thought the exhibition helped to develop students' critical research skills, literacy, independence and awareness of global issues. We wish good luck to our Grade 6 students in their research projects and Look forward to the Exhibition in February.
