All Aboard

A safe ride to and from school is of the utmost importance and every student is asked to do their part in ensuring that this happens. Our goal each year as a school is to provide your children with a safe journey to and from school. To do this successfully we need your understanding and cooperation. Eligibility for bussing is determined by School Board Policy. Our expectation of all bus riders is that children remain seated at all times during the ride. Quiet, courteous discussion with those on the same seat is encouraged. The "right" of riding the school bus comes with "responsibilities". A safe journey is determined by the behaviour of the students, for



they **must** allow the driver to perform his/her duties. The responsibility of our drivers is to ensure he/she drives safely and prudently. He/she must pay close attention to the road and not be disturbed by misbehaving students. Please discuss this with your children – Yes, it is their **right** to ride the bus but it is their **responsibility** to do so in a safe manner. Thank you.

CORN ROAST THANK YOU

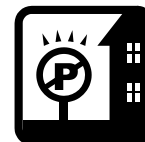

VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS

First, thank you to all those parents who are able to volunteer in the school. Your help is greatly appreciated.

Volunteer Sign In

It is extremely important that we maintain a safe and controlled environment for our students. To this end we must insist that any parent who will be in the building during regular school hours (to

volunteer or meet a teacher etc.) must first check in at the office, sign the visitors book and pick up an ID badge. The visitor must wear the badge for students and teachers to see. The badge should be returned to the office at the end of the visit.

Morning and Afternoons

Parents are asked not to enter the school yard at any time. This rule is necessary in order to help keep our students safe from intruders. For safety purposes we must insist that the school yard be reserved for students and supervisors only. Please remember that parents picking up their children at the daycare after school are asked to remain near the entrance. Thank-you for your understanding.

CWA Eco-corner



Hi everyone, August 29, 2018 may have been the start of the CWA school year for your kids but throughout the year the CWA Green Committee helps the school to become earth-friendly in its everyday activities and events.

During the annual Corn Roast this Fall 2018, by practicing waste triaging, composting and recycling, we ended up with about 12 large bags of compost, 6 large bags of recycling and only 2 bags of landfill, instead of at least 20 bags of garbage, for an event of at least 500 people!!

A special thanks to the group of students from Royal West High School, Derek our CWA evening caretaker and Green Committee members such as David, Caroline, Ivy, Linda and Principal Di Vittori, along with all the Corn Roast volunteers and parents who helped make this event as zero waste as possible!

Since 2014, the Green Committee has been making the school more ecological and sustainable in other activities as well, such as:

- Pasta Night: By using compostable dishes, utensils and cups, along with waste triaging, composting and recycling to reduce all garbage to only 1 bag of landfill for an event of at least 200 people

- Breakfast with Santa: By using compostable dishes, utensils and cups, along with waste triaging, composting and recycling to reduce all garbage to only 1 bag of landfill for the entire school

- Using CWA's own dishware at events such as the Elderly Seniors Lunch to reduce waste and empower students through dish washing Eco-challenges, etc. etc.

Among our plans for this year is tree planting, waste reduction in lunches and a popular grassroots project about weaving mats from plastic milk bags. Canadian milkbags are UV treated and actually are a deterrent to certain bugs. Canada seems to be the only country that has these particular type of milk bags (in the US, milk is sold in cartons and never in those milk bags). These mats are light, long lasting, and are sent to disaster zones and developing countries.
