- As a result of the Federal Election, the Council amended the 2024-2025 School Calendar (Youth Sector) from May 16 th to April 28 th, 2025.
- The Council amended the 2025-2026 School Calendar (Youth Sector). The updated calendar will align with changes resulting from the new provincial collective agreement. A key change includes the addition of a 20 th pedagogical day, as well as the identification of certain pedagogical days as teacher-driven days. May 15, 2026, has been added as a teacher-driven day. There was also a movement of three days; October 31 (previously October 20), January 5 (previously January 23), and January 30 (previously February 6).
- After consultation with the Parents' Committee, Admin Group and the Pearson Teachers' Union (PTU), Council adopted Option #3 for the 2026-2027 Youth Sector and Continuing Education School Calendar. The next step is for schools to add their local ped days, prior to posting.
- The Council approved that the current rental of facilities rates be increased by 3% for the 2025-2026 school year.
