List of items for **Grade 3**. Please trust that the number of pencils and erasers asked for is a realistic reflection of what will be required for the duration of the year.



\*If items used this year are still in good condition, there is no need to buy new ones. Let's be environmentally friendly and think about reusing.

Items required:	(please label with your child's name)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Binder 1.5 inches (any color/design)</li> <li>• 2 Sharpeners (one to keep as a back-up)</li> <li>• 7 duo-tangs (must have metal tabs/fasteners for holes on a page), one each color if possible: 2 red, 1 black, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 orange</li> <li>• 3 letter size paper file folders</li> <li>• 3 writing books <b>interlined-dotted lines (full lined page) - *Interlignes ET pointillés</b> Example: -----</li> </ul> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: 15%;">NO SUBSTITUTION</div> <div style="width: 80%;"> </div> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: 15%; background-color: #fff9c4;">The cover MUST specify interlined-dotted La couverture DOIT spécifier interlignes ET pointillés</div> </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 Exercice Books Ruled 7mm, 32 pages ("Cahier Canada" type)</li> <li>• 1 pack of loose leaf (200 or less) - Feuilles mobiles</li> <li>• 1 plastic pocket folder (chemise à pochettes pour travail à terminer)</li> <li>• 1 Graph Copy Book (cahier quadrillé) 4-1" (square must be app. 0.25 inches)</li> <li>• 20 plastic sheet protectors (with holes that can go in a binder or duo-tang)</li> <li>• 1 pair of scissors, min 6" with pointed tip (not rounded)</li> <li>• 5 Highlighters (any thickness) 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 pink, 1 orange and 1 blue (no substitution as the colors are for grammar related work and uses a color code)</li> <li>• Box of min. 24 coloring pencils</li> <li>• Box of min. 16 Markers (any thickness - student's preference)</li> <li>• 2 socks/cloths (to use as a white board eraser)</li> <li>• Pencil case (preferably 2, one for regular material and one for colored crayons and such)</li> </ul>	
Items required	(Please, DO NOT label these items)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8 Dry Erase Markers (any color/any thickness)</li> <li>• 3 glue sticks (about 40g each)</li> <li>• Pencils (min. 36) - <b>sharpened</b></li> <li>• Erasers (min. 4)</li> <li>• 1 container of modeling compound (texture like PlayDoh)</li> </ul>	

\*\*\* We have written minimum to acknowledge that all children are different. If you know your child tends to misplace things, we highly recommend providing more pencils and erasers throughout the school year. These will be kept in a labeled resealable bag in class.

optional Items	(please label to your child's name)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School bag</li> <li>• Lunch bag</li> <li>• Placemat</li> <li>• 1 box of large or sandwich size resealable/zippered plastic bags</li> <li>• 1 pair of headsets with microphone (if possible as it makes it easier for recording)</li> <li>• 1 USB <b>CORDED</b> mouse (for Chromebooks)</li> <li>• Any kind of inexpensive sketchbook (for free time drawing/doodling)</li> <li>• 1 reusable water bottle bicycle-type with cover (no removable cap for drinking)</li> <li>• 1 smock (or shirt to protect clothes when painting)</li> </ul>	

We recognize that labeling the material can be a tedious process. In our experience, involving the child in the labeling allows them to take **ownership** of the material and they tend to be more careful with it in class, leading to less need for replacing lost items throughout the year. Thank you!
